PARENTAL INVOLVMENT POLICY

It is the policy of the childcare service to promote the active participation of parents in the planning and development of the service, valuing parents as the first educators of their children.

- Parents are encouraged to work as volunteers in the service.
- All contributions are welcomed from parents, whatever form they may take.
- Staff members are available to discuss any concerns a parent may have with the service.
- We aim top provide opportunities for the parents to learn about the curriculum in the centre and about young children's learning, while in our care and at home.
